

## **HOMELESS AND HOUSING ASSISTANCE**

At Dixon Family Services, Case Managers can assist families and individuals in Dixon who qualify for housing assistance programs. Each program has guidelines and documentation requirements. **ALL** housing assistance programs require the recipients to verify their ability to maintain their housing costs in future months once the program has helped them. **NONE** of these programs are for emergencies. Assistance applications can only be processed when all requested verifications have been submitted. The process of screening and possible approval of assistance takes time.

### **Verifications include, but are not limited to:**

- Proper Identification for all family members
- Proof of Residency
- Income Verification for all members of household
- Rental Contract, or landlord/tenant agreement
- Applied for Section 8?
- What else has been done to resolve this problem?
- Ability to contribute towards delinquent rent or move-in costs
- Complete Budget, including all incomes and all debts, expenses in recent months
- Willingness to address Underlying Causes of problem
- Willingness to participate in on-going Case Management to achieve Self-Sufficiency
- Willingness to participate in Workshops and Trainings that can help, such as: Budgeting and Balancing, Tenants' Rights and Responsibilities, and others
- Verified Need
- Ability to Maintain
- Employment History
- Rental History

**It is recommended** that homeless families and individuals use their existing resources of family and friends to maintain temporary shelter. Persons who are homeless, or semi-homeless, with no clear possibility of moving into, or maintaining permanent housing, will be referred to Solano County Homeless Shelter programs, and/or Shelters in other counties.
